School Uniforms

Uniform items available for purchase through the P&C include:

- Gold Polo shirts for Early Years and Primary Students,
- Bottle Green and Gold Polo shirts for Secondary Students,
- School Hats.

Students must have a hat with a brim that will protect their face and neck (preferably a bucket hat), and they must wear enclosed shoes to protect their feet.

Payment is to be made by cash in an envelope – marked "Uniform Order – Attention P&C Uniform Convenor or by direct deposit to the Pine Rivers Special School P&C at the time of placing the order. (Details can be found on the Uniform Order Form.)

Other uniform items can be purchased from stores such as Lowes, Best and Less, Big W and other retail outlets to suit the needs of the student.

Free Dress Days

Occasionally students are invited to participate in Free Dress or Dress-Up Days. While we like students to enjoy these days, it is important to remember that clothing must always comply with:

- Sun Safe policy
- Shoulders and upper arms should be covered
- An appropriate hat and shoes should be worn.

Hair

Students' hair should be neat and tidy. It is advisable for long hair to be tied back.

Makeup & Jewellery

While students are allowed to wear some jewellery, it is advised that expensive jewellery should not be worn to school, for fear of being lost.
